RECOMMENDATIONS/CONSIDERATIONS:

- All students should be accessible with your device during your regularly scheduled classes to participate in class or communicate with your teacher. Teachers will be available during their scheduled periods for students to contact them via email, Zoom or otherwise with questions, comments or needs.
- Regular daily attendance in your classes is critical for your continued growth. If you are unable to join the class for one reason or another or have connectivity or technology issues that interfere, please communicate this with your teacher as soon as possible.
- Deadlines and due dates are at the discretion of your teachers as always. It is important that you stay on top of your work as this will impact your ability to keep up with your work, stay on pace and will affect your grades.
- Today is the end of the 3rd marking period. I have extended the time your teachers have to submit grades due to the chaos following our closure this week. It is our hope that this may only delay our posting of grades a few days. More information will follow.

- **IMPORTANT** ⇒ Daily approach to class and means by which students and teachers connect will vary based upon your teacher and their instructional choices, comfort level and capabilities. Teachers will inform you of their expectations. So what this mean...
- Some classes may meet daily via teleconferencing (Zoom) or some who may choose to only meet through this means on occasion. Some faculty may not have the connectivity to utilize Zoom and therefore not gather this way. If teachers will utilize Zoom, they will share with you how to join a Zoom meeting and you will receive an invitation via an email from your teacher for each of these meetings.
 - Depending on instructional focus and needs, your teacher may assign a longer term activity or project and choose to use class time to allow you to work. Keep in mind that your teacher should be available during class time if you need to email them with a question or concern.
 - Some of your teachers may choose to communicate using GMail or our Google platform to provide work, share documents, video or other links and in return to receive work.

While we have put a considerable amount of time and energy into organizing and orchestrating a distance learning approach, we do anticipate that issues, surprises and additional challenges will arise. Throughout this unprecedented time and to ensure our educational efforts are as effective as possible, we ask for your patience, understanding and open communication. If an issue arises please address this as quickly as possible with your teacher or if need be, Mrs. Smithley or myself.

My intent is to make every effort to communicate with students and parents on a daily basis, most likely in the morning. I will use this as a way to share information, encourage and most importantly to maintain some connection with all of you.
