NEW DIPLOMA TRACKS



We are excited to announce that starting this year, Houghton Academy is <u>now offering four unique diploma tracks!</u>

The following diploma tracks are available to Houghton Academy students:

COLLEGE PREPARATORY DIPLOMA (22 Credits)

- Meets minimum NYSED graduation requirements.
- Twenty-two credits (minimum) are required for graduation, including:
 - · 4 credits (each) English, Social Studies
 - o 3 credits (each) Math, Science
 - o 2 credits (each) Foreign Language, Physical Education
 - 1 credit Fine Arts
 - 0.5 credit Health
 - 2.5 credits Electives

NOTE: 1 Christian Studies/Bible credit is required for each full year of Houghton Academy enrollment.

COLLEGE PREP PLUS DIPLOMA (25 Credits)

• This diploma requires three (3) additional credits in upper-level courses (e.g., AP, Honors).

DIPLOMA OF EXCELLENCE (28 Credits)

- This diploma requires:
 - Three (3) additional credits in college-level dual enrollment
 - A minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 or weighted G.P.A. of 83 or higher

DIPLOMA OF EXCELLENCE AND EMPHASIS (30 Credits)

- This diploma requires:
 - Two (2) additional credits in an area of emphasis (e.g., STEM, Fine Arts)
 - o A minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 or weighted G.P.A. of 83 or higher
