Following the upcoming holiday weekend, Houghton

Academy students will participate in either the Middle School or High School Retreat. Please take a few minutes to review the important information below:

INFORMATION FOR **ALL** STUDENTS:

- Bring a water bottle (temperatures are expected to be high)
- Wear comfortable athletic clothing (modest gym clothes or better)
- Wear sneakers (no Crocks)
- Bring sunscreen
- Bring bug spray
- Students must remain in an adult-supervised area at all times (i.e., no straying off)
- Cell phones are permitted for taking pictures or during scheduled free times with adult permission.
- LOCAL PARENTS MUST COMPLETE THIS RELEASE FORM

MIDDLE SCHOOL RETREAT DETAILS:

- MS Students will be enjoying Houghton University's EPIC Adventures
- Arrive to the Academy at 8:30 am on Tuesday and Wednesday
- Students will return to the Academy for pick-up at 3:00 pm
- Lunch is provided at Houghton University

HIGH SCHOOL RETREAT DETAILS:

- HS Students will be enjoying Penn-York Camp & Retreat Center
- Bring swimwear for the Water Slide and Pool (Girls, two-piece bathing suits must be covered with a T-shirt)
- Luggage can be no larger than a roll-aboard
- Bring a sheet, blanket, pillow, or sleeping bag

- Note that this is not a "couples" retreat (i.e., No PDA)
- No boys may enter a girl's cabin. No girls may enter a boy's cabin.
- A curfew will be strictly enforced.
- Defiant behavior (e.g., refusing to assist others or participate) is grounds for parents being called to take the student home.
- Violation of any expectations is grounds for removal from the retreat and additional discipline up to and including expulsion from Houghton Academy.
