Congratulations Grace!


2023 Family Cookout / Homecoming Success

In addition, dozens of family and community members joined us for a beautiful afternoon of food and fun (including the photo booth pictured above with middle school students and Dr. T.).





COLLEGE PREPARATORY DIPLOMA (22 CREDITS)

(Meets minimum NYSED graduation requirements).

Twenty-two credits (minimum) are required for graduation, including:

4 CREDITS (each) English

Social Studies

3 CREDITS (each) Math

Science

2 CREDITS (each) Foreign Language

Physical Education

1 CREDIT Fine Arts

0.5 CREDIT Health

2.5 CREDITS Electives

NOTE: 1 Christian Studies/Bible credit is required for each full year of Houghton Academy enrollment.
