

The books and resources are FREE, although a donation to the Academy is always appreciated.


Engaged Learning

From the Athletic Director



Houghton Academy Families and Student-Athletes,

Here is the information needed for pre-season sports at Houghton Academy. The dates for Volleyball and

Soccer will be August 21-25thVolleyball will be practicing from 5:30-8:30 pm every weekday. Soccer will practice from 5-7 pm every weekday (in case of rain, then practice will be indoors 4-6 pm), except Friday, which will be earlier due to the boarding student retreat.

An important reminder that every athlete will need an updated physical to play. Here is a link to the physical form that needs to be filled out by the physician: <u>https://drive.google.com/file/d/1R6CbADobWCThLGEsjWV13wrODcWQTjLt/view?</u> <u>usp=sharing</u>

As of July 1, 2022, NY State passed a new law that requires this form to be filled out if your physical was completed more than 30 days ago. This form would be completed by the parent/guardian only, not the doctor. All student-athletes should show up to the first practice in athletic wear. This means cleats, shin guards, athletic shorts, and t-shirts for soccer. Volleyball players need rubber-soled shoes, knee pads, athletic shorts, and t-shirts. I hope you all enjoy the rest of your summer, and we'll see you soon on the court/fields.
